In order to ensue processing of your application for a Mining Lease/ Special Mining Lease, the following are to be submitted along with three (3) copies of the application form:

✓ Application Fee:-

ML: New - \$1,200 per Km<sup>2</sup> / Renewal - \$600 per Km<sup>2</sup>

SML: New / Renewal - \$1, 200 per Km<sup>2</sup>

- √ Prospecting Right
- √ Prospecting Licence
- ✓ Location map (Total area being applied for) 1:50,000 scale
- ✓ Financial Statement (Individual/ Company)
- ✓ Articles of Incorporation
- ✓ A Sketch Plan (Detailing financing of planned operations within sections of total area along with a sketch of each section)

#### **PLEASE NOTE:-**

A location beacon must be erected at the North West (N.W.) corner of the area displaying the name of the company and date executed.
